Landfill Team Begins North Quarry Liner Installation

BRIDGETON, MO (May 19, 2017) — The Bridgeton Landfill team announced today the start of work to install additional liner over the North Quarry. The Ethylene Vinyl Alcohol (EVOH) geomembrane cover is another proactive site enhancement that will further supplement existing odor controls.

Once installed, the North Quarry EVOH cover will add to the 46-acres of cover already in place at the site. Subgrade preparations for the project were completed the week of May 8.
